

Fresno County Regional Long Range Transit Plan RFP

Questions and Answers

1. Under Task 3.4. the RFP states that the consultant should "Perform modeling analysis and compare the performance of the transit alternatives using the performance measures established in Task 3.1" Can you elaborate on the level of modeling analysis needed and what modeling tools should be used?

Answer: Fresno COG's traffic model, any other transit ridership forecast tools or innovative quantification methodology can be used in the modeling analysis to evaluate the impact of different transit alternatives. The modeling analysis is expected to quantify the difference of impacts from the transit scenarios to the extent possible based on the performance measures that will be established under Task 3.1.

2. Does Fresno COG want recommendations for projects to be included in the 2018 RTP/SCS, or is the focus on the subsequent 2022 RTP/SCS?.

Answer: the Long Range Regional Transit Plan will provide input for the transit strategies in the RTP/SCS. Due to the timing of the project, it is expected that the focus will be the 2022 RTP/SCS. However, it is hoped that the process of formulating the transit alternatives could be helpful to the transit agencies in their brainstorming about the transit projects for the 2018 RTP/SCS.
