Mr. Yazdi:

The Executive Director of the Fresno Council of Governments as authorized by the Policy Board hereby approves Amendment No. 7 (Types 2 and 3 Formal) to the 2017 FTIP.

This amendment includes projects whose cost changes are greater than 40% of the total project cost or more than \$10 million, changes to the Grouped Project Listing, new and deleted projects and updates to the financial summary tables. The enclosed financial summary affirms that the 2017 FTIP is financially constrained and funding is available. This FTIP Amendment No. 7 is consistent with the 2014 Regional Transportation Plan. The FTIP as amended meets all of the applicable transportation planning requirements per 23 CFR Part 450 and 40 CFR Part 93. The funding changes do not interfere with the timely implementation of any approved TCMs, and the TIP as amended conforms to the applicable SIP. The changes do not interfere with air quality conformity or changes to conformity analysis years; therefore a new conformity determination is not required. State and Federal approval will be required.

Fresno COG conducted a 7-day public review and interagency consultation period that was completed on October 11, 2017 at 4:30 pm. One comment was received and the comment with response is included in this amendment package. The public participation process for Amendment No. 7 is consistent with the Fresno COG Board adopted Public Participation Plan.

***Response to Comments to FCOG Amendment No. 7 to the 2017 Federal
Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP)***

The Fresno Council of Governments (FCOG) received 1 (one) comment on the 2017 FTIP Amendment No. 7. The public review and comment period began on October 4, 2017 and ended on October 11, 2017 at 4:30 p.m. Amendment No. 7 was posted on the FCOG website for public review at www.fresnocog.org.

Comment No. 1

Comment was submitted on October 11, 2017 via telephone by Renee Mathis, City of Clovis, regarding FRE150045, LSTMP513.

On behalf of the City of Clovis, I am requesting a change to project FRE150045, LSTMP513, Class I Sierra Gateway Regional Trail. I am requesting that the word “infrastructure” be added to the description in order to emphasize the fact that the City will be installing the infrastructure for the security lighting, and not the actual lighting. The project description should be corrected to read, “Shepherd Avenue to DeWolf Avenue, along the north side of State Route 168, south of Harlan Ranch: Complete final design and secure NEPA approval, then construct 1.6 miles of a 12-foot asphalt concrete trail, landscaping, irrigation system, electrical system, and security lighting infrastructure”

This correction to the project description does not affect the financial constraints or the conformity of the project.

Response: The description has been updated as part of Amendment 7.

The Fresno Council of Governments (FCOG) is proposing a Formal Amendment (Types 2 and 3) to the 2017 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). The 2017 FTIP is the programming document that identifies four years (FY16/17, FY17/18, FY 18/19 and FY 19/20) of federal, state and local funding sources for projects in Fresno County. The proposed amendment will be circulated for a 7-day public comment period. Fresno COG's adopted amendment procedures do not require a public hearing for Amendment Types 2 and 3. Additionally, Types 2 and 3 amendments can be approved by the Fresno COG Executive Director as authorized by the Fresno COG Policy Board.

The FTIP as amended meets all of the applicable transportation planning requirements per 23 CFR Part 450. This amendment includes projects whose cost changes are greater than 40% of the total project cost or more than \$10 million, changes to the grouped project listing, new and deleted projects and updates to the financial summary tables. FTIP Amendment No. 7 is consistent with the 2014 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP). The funding changes do not interfere with the timely implementation of any approved TCMs, and the TIP as amended conforms to the applicable SIP. The changes do not interfere with air quality conformity or changes to conformity analysis years; therefore, a new conformity determination is not required. State and Federal approval will be required.

Public Input

This amendment will be available for a 7-day public review and comment period beginning October 4, 2017 and concluding on October 11, 2017. Comments will be accepted on the FTIP amendment until 4:30 pm on October 11, 2017. Public notice of public involvement activities and time established for public review and comments on this FTIP amendment will satisfy the program of projects (POP) requirements for Federal Transit Administration (FTA) projects.
