Subject: Amendment No. 6 (Administrative Modification) to the 2011 Fresno Council of Governments Federal Transportation Improvement Plan

Mr. Jacobs:

The Executive Director of the Fresno Council of Governments (FCOG) as authorized by the Policy Board hereby approves Amendment #6 (Administrative Modification) to the 2011 Federal Transportation Improvement Plan (FTIP). Please see Attachment #1 for specified administrative changes to the FTIP.

It should be noted that the changes to these projects contained within this amendment do not require a re-determination of the air quality conformity analysis.

You should be aware that as per FCOG's adopted *Policies and Procedures*, Administrative Modifications are to be used whenever "minor" changes related to project costs, selection, or programming occurs. The projects being adjusted meet the criteria. The administrative modification adds new programming capacity of \$3,729,105 to the current financial revenue plan for FCOG's FTIP that relies on the State's federal programming capacity. The programming capacity to modify these projects will be reflected in FCOG's next FTIP formal amendment which will update the financial plan for the actual funding needed to support the added programming capacity from this modification. Also, Administrative Modifications are used in lieu of standard FTIP Formal Amendments, and as such, are not subject to Federal approval. The purpose of this letter is to notify Caltrans, the Federal Highway Administration, and Federal Transit Administration that this Administrative Modification has taken place. We have updated our system, FresnoTrak, to reflect this amendment and will be uploading information into the California Transportation Improvement Program System (CTIPS).
