**RE: Availability of Draft Amendment No. 8 to the 2013 FTIP for Interagency Consultation and Public Review**

The Fresno Council of Governments (FCOG) is proposing a Formal Amendment (Types 2 and 3) to the 2013 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). The 2013 FTIP is the programming document that identifies four years (FY 12/13, FY 13/14, FY14/15, and FY15/16) of federal, state and local funding sources for projects in Fresno County. The proposed amendment will be circulated for a 7-day public comment period. Fresno COG's adopted amendment procedures do not require a public hearing for Amendment Types #2 and #3. Additionally, Types #2 and #3 amendments can be approved by the Fresno COG Executive Director as authorized by the Fresno COG Policy Board.

The FTIP as amended meets all of the applicable transportation planning requirements per 23 CFR Part 450. This amendment includes projects whose cost changes are greater than 40% of the total project cost or more than \$10 million, changes to the grouped project listing and updates to the financial summary tables. FTIP Amendment No. 8 is consistent with the 2011 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP). The funding changes do not interfere with the timely implementation of any approved TCMs, and the TIP as amended conforms to the applicable SIP. The changes do not interfere with air quality conformity or changes to conformity analysis years; therefore, a new conformity determination is not required. State and Federal approval will be required.

#### Public Input

This amendment will be available for a 7 day public review and comment period beginning July 26, 2013 concluding on August 1, 2013. Comments will be accepted on the FTIP amendment until 4:30 pm on August 1, 2013.
